Week #2: Eternal Understanding

Intercession Recognizes *Need and Supply*.

As we intercede, we are calling upon God to provide power, access, wisdom, words, insight, etc. that can only come from Him. This session is all about the supernatural understanding of praying, because God is Spirit, and that directly implies that He is a supernatural (*other, beyond-natural*) being.

- Access
- Wisdom
- Words
- Insight

Handling and Engaging with this kind of supernatural power.

In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord seated on a throne, high and exalted, and the train of his robe filled the temple. Above him were seraphs, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory." At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty." Then one of the seraphs flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. With it he touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for." Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!" ([Isaiah 6:1-8 NIV84](#))

- GOD: High ... exalted ... seated on a throne ... majestic ... angels attend Him ... "Holy, holy holy!"
- US: Woe to me! ... I am ruined! ... I have unclean lips! ... I live among people with unclean lips!
- WHAT HAPPENS ... The live coal ... purification ... worthiness is imparted ... access ... SEND ME!

"In the Spirit"

- "On the Lord's day I was in the Spirit..." (Rev 1:10) John
- "pray in the Holy Spirit." (Jude 1:20)
- "For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit." (2 Peter 1:21)
- "...and who also told us of your love in the Spirit." (Colossians 1:8) Paul
- "And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints." (Ephesians 6:18) Paul
- "Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit." (Galatians 5:25) Paul
- "In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God's will." (Romans 8:26-27) Paul
- "Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks." (John 4:23) Jesus

IN THE SPIRIT:

- Recognition of the presence of God within.
- The experience of the guidance and direction of the Spirit within.
- The expectation that He will meet me, guide me, empower me, provide for me, and intercede for me.
- Operating by faith in the invisible power that comes from being filled with the Holy Spirit.
- Trusting for words when we faithfully open our mouths.
- Obeying anything and everything the Spirit would ask of us.
- Operating in the reality of the insight the Holy Spirit provides to us.

Prophetic Intercession

Prophetic intercession emerges when we pray out of the resources of God.

Prophetic Intercession is the human voice audibly, powerfully, prayerfully, speaking the will of God, back to God, declaring the heart of God over persons, groups, regions, nations and the world.

We need more prophetic intercessors today, because we simply don't know how to pray, *but not praying is not an option.*

"In the Spirit" is the necessary gateway to supernatural prayer

- Prophetic Intercession
- Tongues and Interpretation
- Visions
- Dreams
- Healing
- Miracles, Signs & Wonders

It's okay for you to desire the gift of prophecy!

- Eagerly desire the greater gifts. (1 Cor 12:31)
- 1 Cor Chapters 12-14 need to be an encouragement for the gifts, not a barrier.

Let's Connect the Dots from Session One

- Eyes, ears, voice. (What God sees, hears, has said, and is saying)
- Mind, will, heart (The mind of Christ, the will of Christ, the heart of Christ)
- Hands, feet (Where Christ sends me, What Christ asks of me)
- When the WELL is the Holy Spirit, these all become prophetic acts.

Application

- Be on location with intention.
- Be surrendered and ready to listen, but be careful not to force.
- Be humble and double-check what you are concerned of.
- Don't trust every word... there are always counterfeits where there is a genuine move of God.
- Engage your voice. Verbally pray out and declare what you are seeing and hearing.
- War against discouragement or lack of faith. Trust God.
